Mathematics without Borders

The Contest Kangaroo (also known as Mathematics without Borders) is an international event guided by the international association "Mathematiques Pour Tous" (Mathematics for all). Association was created in 1990 and now unites more than 30 countries from all over the world. Pakistan is admitted as the member of the Association in October 2004. The responsibility for the Contest in Pakistan is taken by School of Mathematical Sciences (Lahore) with Chairman Pakistan Kangaroo commission, Dr. A. D. R. Choudary, Director General School of Mathematical Sciences.

The aim of the Kangaroo is to promote the spreading of a basic mathematical culture by organizing an annual Contest to be held on the same day in all participating countries. The Contest is based on the participation of the greatest number of young people at all ages, interests and abilities. The Contest is composed of just one test, no preliminary, no selection, no final test. It takes place in March on the same day in all countries and consists of 20-30 simple and attractive questions of increasing difficulty with given possible answers.

Under the trademark Kangaroo books on mathematics are widely spread. In that environment the Association tries to promote exchanges between the students and teachers all over the world. Every year national and international summer-camps are organized for the winners.

The big part of the Contest's budget is foreseen for prizes for at least 20% of the participants in every school. Each participant receives an International Certificate. In 2005 the Kangaroo Contest will be held on March 17, in every school that will confirm its willingness by December 10, 2004. The Contest is partially financed by the participation fee, which is Rs. 60 per participant for Govt. Institutions and Rs. 100 per participant for Private Institutions.

To help School of Mathematical Sciences organize this event, an institution may nominate mathematics teachers who can serve as coordinators for this program at that institution. This person must be an enthusiastic teacher of mathematics. The coordinator will receive some financial assistance from the organizing body of the program. The nominations can be sent, by filling out the registration form available from SMS, to the following address:
