

## 2 Findings

The transfer of IKMC from a university to an employee & representative of the university (as far as the IKMC was concerned) should have raised many questions from within the university. Committee members are aware of the informal conversations regarding the transfer as far back as late 2014. However, given that AS-SMS was a very closed entity with very little interaction with the local mathematics community it is quite understandable that many in the Pakistani mathematics community were not even aware that the Director-General is conducting for himself a for-profit business using the resources and staff of the school.


The BoG decision was based on facts regarding the way Kangaroo Competition is organized in other countries. These facts were conveyed to the BoG by Dr. ADR Choudary and were supported by the email from André Deledicq. The statements that Dr. ADR Choudary made to the BoG regarding the way IKMC is organized in other countries were false as there are many countries in which universities and mathematics centers organize the contest. Also, the email which was claimed by Dr. ADR Choudary to be from André Deledicq it seems was not from André Deledicq as confirmed by the AKSF. There is no doubt that false statements and documents were presented to the BoG to get IKMC *privatized*. It is the opinion of one of the members of the committee (Amer Iqbal) that BoG members did not carry out due diligence in this case which was just a matter of simple internet search. Whether this negligence by the members of the BoG was mere incompetence or whether it was collusion with Dr. ADR Choudary is impossible to determine now.

The Director-General of the school, the position that Dr. ADR Choudary occupied at the time of these events, is an MP-1 position which is one of the highest in the government. This makes the use of fake/forged documents and false statements to the BoG for personal financial gains a grave misuse of authority.

After 2008 all the amount collected as fees were deposited in some private bank account and the school has no direct record of the amount collected. There is plenty of evidence even when the registration fee collected from students was being used for private gains the competition was still being organized using the resources and staff of the school.

The committee estimates that from 2009 to 2018 approximately Rs. 278 Million (~ \$ 2.24 Million) have been generated through this contest.


